Your first costume deposit payment is due by 10/15/2016. The fee is \$100 per main class and \$25 per additional class. ***If your dancer is a mini, in Level classes or in any combination (tap/ballet, tap/ballet/jazz) your deposit is \$100. There will be an additional \$25 added to that per extra class (i.e.: gymnastics, hip hop etc.).***

If gymnastics or hip hop is your only class, your costume deposit is only \$25.00.
